

WHMCS Server Module Installation

- 1) Login to www.VPNresellers.com for your API key/Access token.
- 2) Using FTP or SSH, create a folder called 'vpnresellers' in the directory /modules/servers on your server.
- 3) Using FTP, transfer the file "vpnresellers.php" and "clientarea.tpl" to the directory you just created: /modules/servers/vpnresellers
- 4) Navigate to your WHMCS Admin Panel and log in
- 5) Create a new Product
- 6) Under the 'Module Settings' Tab for module name select 'vpnresellers'
 - a. Copy and paste the API key/Access token into field Access token (see step 1)
 - B. Choose when you would like the service to be setup

- 7) Under the 'Custom Fields' Tab
 - a. Field Name: "Username"
 - b. Field Type: "Text Box"
 - c. Description: "Username for your VPN account"
 - i. This is merely an example, use whatever you deem best.
 - d. Validation: "/^[a-z\d_]{4,28}\$/i"
 - i. A username between 4 and 28 characters in length, alpha-numeric, and allowing underscores
 - e. Check "Required Field" and "Show on Order Form"
 - f. Save changes

- 8) In your email template for service creation you can use the following merge fields to display the customers username and generated password.
 - a. Username: “{\$service_custom_fields.0}”
 - b. Password: “{\$service_password}”
 - i. When users update their service password it will automatically update our databases.
